

# Tasting Notes 2023





Drinks can only be purchased using tokens available from the Cashier Desks priced at £12 per sheet. No cash will be accepted at the bars. Time at the bar is 15 minutes prior to closing, with a further 15 minutes drinking-up time.



#### 360 Brewing Bark at the Moon 4.0%

A smooth session stout, rich and toasty, with a hint of coffee balanced by mellow notes of molasses and dark chocolate.

#### Volks 5.5%

A strong bitter with a caramel copper colour and a mixed powerful aroma of toffee, liquorice, plum, damson, honey and biscuit.

#### Battle Alan the Red 4.4%

In this ruby beer, rye adds a dry, spicy character to the caramel malt body and fruity hop flavours.

#### One-Hop Wonder 4.0%

This refreshing single-hopped pale ale is brewed with a different hop each time, combined with English two-row barley and wheat.

#### Cellar Head Amber Ale 4.0%

A sweet floral aroma of orange blossom and a biscuity, toasty malt flavour with light bitterness and a gentle marmalade finish.

#### Session Pale Ale 3.8% 0

Straw coloured with tropical fruit and sweet floral aromas, with gooseberry, green grapes and light honey flavours.

#### Downlands Bramber 4.5%

Punchy tropical notes give way to a rich malty base in this modern American-style amber ale.

#### Filo Cardinal 4.6% 🛙

A classic black porter brewed with chocolate malt and roasted barley to leave a smooth deep flavour.

#### Gold 4.8% 0

Premium gold-coloured bitter with hints of elderflower that add to a smooth texture.

#### Gun

#### Chummy Bluster 4.4%

A best bitter, gentle, fruity and well-rounded ale, with a subtle hint of smokiness balanced with bitterness.

#### Parabellum Milk Stout 4.1%

Made with barley, oats, wheat and roasted chocolate malts, giving a balance of coffee, vanilla and chocolate flavours.

#### Harvey's Armada 4.5% 🛛

A golden ale with vibrant hop tones and a dry finish.

#### Sussex Best Bitter 4.0%

A blend of four local hops creates this classic copper-coloured bitter.

#### Kissingate Black Cherry Mild 4.2% A full fruit and flavoursome dark

mild with subtle additions of real black cherries and gentle hopping.

#### Little Green Nutter 5.0%

A green-hopped amber beer using handpicked hops and hazelnuts balanced with full biscuit maltiness.

#### Smelters Stout 5.1%

A stout with flavours of dark chocolate and a gentle bittersweet finish, with a hint of wood smoke.

#### Lakedown Best Bitter 4.2% []

Flavoured with British biscuity malts, it uses UK Pioneer, Cascade and Jester hops to create a traditional best bitter.

#### Spring Ale 3.8%

Grassy and floral with a lovely crisp finish, low bitterness and easy-drinking.

#### Lister's Premium Gold 5.0% 🛛

Rich and fruity. Golden ochre in colour with rounded citrus notes, this is a deep and satisfying ale.

#### Special Ale 4.6%

A smooth premium bitter, russet brown in colour with roasted and toasted malt aroma.

#### Long Man Best Bitter 4.0%

A traditional Sussex-style best bitter, balanced with a bittersweet malty taste, fragrant hops and lingering flavour.

#### Old Man 4.3%

This original dark beer has soft malt notes of coffee and chocolate that combine with a pleasant light hoppiness to create a rich, full-tasting old ale of times gone by.

#### Rising Giant 4.8% 🛛

Made using only the choicest U.S. hops, this triple-hopped American pale ale has a pleasant citrus fruit aroma and characteristic robust bitterness.

#### Only With Love Firecracker ESB 5.2%

An extra-strong bitter with flavours of malty caramel, biscuits and raisins, with a subtle aroma of tropical fruit.

#### Harlequin Single Hop Sunshine Ale 3.9%

With a peach and passion fruit bouquet, this golden beer is brewed solely with whole leaf Harlequin hops.

#### Rother Valley Hoppers Ale 4.4%

A copper-coloured bitter using only Goldings hops, the initial bitterness is followed by a pleasant caramel taste.

#### Level Zest 4% 🛛

Light bronze colour with lush orange bitterness and hoppy floral notes.

#### Three Acre Best Bitter 4.0%

A modern take on the traditional best bitter using malts and English hops.

#### Hazy Pale 4.6% []

An APÁ-style beer with a gentle haze, rich grain is balanced by a mango aroma.

#### UnBarred ESB 5.6%

A strong and full-bodied deep mahogany ale. Fuggle and Goldings hops give a mellow bitterness with a morish finish.

### National Beers

#### Arbor Blue Sky Drinking 4.4%

A tawny best bitter with full-bodied malt, balanced by delicate citrus notes and a clean bitter finish.

#### Brick Peckham Pale 4.5% 🛛

A vegan North American-style pale ale. Extra pale malt is blended with Crystal malt and a mix of hops gives bitter, fruit and floral notes.

#### Bristol Beer Factory Challenge Accepted 4.4%

A deep amber 80 Shilling made with Scottish pale malt, with caramel and dark chocolate flavours and subtle blackcurrant and herbal notes.

### N O T E S

#### Fell Tinderbox 6.3% 🛛

A classic West Coast-style IPA. Dry and bitter, the hops are piney, resinous and pithy.

#### Fyne Ales Highlander 4.8%

A dark amber-coloured bittersweet ale with a taste of rich caramel malts, a touch of toffee and soft citrus flavours.

#### Little Critters Blonde Bear 4.2% []

A blonde ale with light caramel malt complementing the whole hops used, it has a light body with hints of tropical fruit.

#### Marble Manchester Bitter 4.2% []

This classic Mancunian bitter holds initial citrus aroma that gives way to a full palate and a dry, bitter finish.

#### Moor Illumination 4.3%

Taking strong influences from Timmy Taylor's Landlord, this is a well-rounded lighter best bitter.

### Northern Whisper

**Oppenchops 4.0%** Brewed in the post-industrial heartlands of Lancashire, a true northern-styled golden ale.

#### Pig & Porter Caravan 3.6%

Caramel and toffee flavours from the malts and a fruity punch, notably tangerine, from English yeast and hops.

#### Salopian Lemon Dream 4.5%

A golden ale brewed using organic lemons which adds subtle zesty aromas and a citrus-filled fruity finish.

### Saltaire

#### **Titus 3.9%** 🛛

Classic English pale bitter with light malt base and spicy fruitiness from the Challenger, Bramling Cross and Cascade hops.

#### Tiny Rebel Chocka Block 4.8% **V**

A chocolate stout with a certain sweetness.

#### Titanic Cappuccino Stout 4.5% 🛽

A combination of brewer and barista add to the original dry Titanic Stout, bringing the flavours of smooth cappuccino.

### Verdant

**Argal 4.4%** A golden ale with Munich malt

complexity and a bitter finish, with notes of orange, mango and grapefruit.

#### Craft Beers KeyKeg

#### Anspach & Hobday London Black 4.4%

A creamy and smooth texture balanced with subtle roasted notes of coffee and chocolate.

#### Beak Dest 5.0% []

Crisp, clean and hoppy, this unfiltered, naturally-carbonated lager is brewed with German hops and Pilsner malt.

#### Locals 6.0% 0

A soft IPA brewed with Citra and Nelson Sauvin hops for flavours of lychee, Chenin Blanc grapes and honeydew melon.

#### Neno 6.0% 🛛

Brewed with Motueka hops giving flavours of lime, lemon and ripe peaches.

#### Parade 6.0% 0

Fruit bubble gum flavours of mango, orange peel, pineapple and ripe flat peaches.

#### Burning Sky Easy Answers 6.0% []

IPA with good body and subdued bitterness, topped off with piney aroma hops and a double dry hop for flavour.

#### Luppoleto Pils 5.2%

Brewed with Pilsner malt and noble German hop varieties, with flavours of cereal malt, citrus and grassy hop aromas.

#### Spend Your Wishes 6.5%

A classic red IPA, layered through the boil with Simcoe hops and then dry hopped with four varieties.

#### Double Barrelled Parka 4.5% 🛛

A gentle bitterness from Cascade and Centennial hops contrasts with citrus fruit flavours from dry hopping with Citra.

#### GlassHouse Flutter 5.8% []

A zesty aroma and a dry hop of Motueka, Mosaic and Idaho 7 gives flavours of passion fruit, satsuma and kiwi.

#### Gun Project Babylon 4.6% []

A classic APA with a combination of very pale malts and American hops, zesty on the nose, with citrus notes and a dry finish.

#### Scaramanga 3.9% []

A refreshing extra pale session ale, brewed with extra pale malts and zesty and floral hops.

#### The Kernel India Pale Lager 6.7% []

Hopped with Galaxy from Australia, it has tropical notes of mango and peach, with a slightly grassy and malty finish.

#### **Overtone** Easy to Find 5.0% []

A smooth pale ale with mango and pineapple flavours, a hint of lychee and big on grapefruit and lemon.

#### Pomona Island Child of Nature 6.5% []

A double dry-hopped IPA using Mosaic, Idaho 7, Sabro and Bru-I hops.

#### **Rivington** No Day for a Do 6.0% **D**

A double dry-hopped IPA with a tropical aroma of grape, passion fruit and gooseberry, hopped with Nelson Sauvin.

#### Route 21 Dark Skies 4.9% 🛙

An oatmeal stout blending dark roasted malts, sweet crystal malt and silky oats. Challenger hops are in the background.

#### Stroll 5.3% []

A hazy pale with a malt base of oats and wheat, brewed with Citra hops and dry hopped with Amarillo.

#### UnBarred Honeyberry Pie Pastry Sour 6.7%

Added to a tart Berliner Weisse base are vanilla, cinnamon and honeyberries.

#### Stoutzilla Imperial Stout 10.0%

A stout with cocoa nibs, Madagascan vanilla, Bourbon whiskey and cold steeped coffee, added to roasted malts.

Mango 4.0% Exotic meld of cooking and eating apples, and tropical fruit.

**Raspberry Ripple 4.0%** Raspberry fruit bite with vanilla softness.

**Rhubarb 4.0%** Crisp rhubarb in a bed of soft apple sweetness.

Temple Medium Dry Cider 6.0% Relatively new maker with a wonderfully rounded cider.

Trenchmore (Cowfold) (S) Silly Moo Cider 5.0% Naturally cloudy, mix of East and West Country styles.

Ventons Sweet Maid in Devon 6.5% Totally real, traditional, naturally sweet keeved cider.

Winkleigh Sam's Crisp Cider 4.5% Irresistibly crisp and fruity.
