● Livin' Free 4.5% □ A bright, hoppy pale ale, brewed in collaboration with Goodness Brewing Co. (gf)

2 Volks 5.5% Powerful aroma of toffee, liquorice, plum, damson, honey and biscuit.

3 Signature 4.4% Very pale, sweet and malty front with a surprising dry, bitter back taste.

Triple Champion 4% Deep chestnut, old-fashioned English bitter with a rich, malty back taste.

5 Castle 3.8% Traditional bitter ale, with fruity hop aromas and a sweet, malty flavour.

6 Printworks 3.4% Smooth, easy-drinking, with hoppy juiciness and low bitterness.

B Armada 4.5% A dry-hopped golden ale, with vibrant hop tones and a dry finish.

Best 4% A superbly balanced bitter with prominent hop character.

29 Dark Mild 3% Malty and mellow. Soft and slightly sweet with a dry, nutty aftertaste akin to an infusion of ground nuts.

2 Lewes Castle 4.8%

Classic brown ale with a sweet palate and notes of coffee and liquorice.

2 Black Cherry Mild 4.2% Subtle additions of black cherries and gentle hopping create this flavoursome dark mild.

23 Powder Blue 5.5% Full-bodied, dark roasted backbone. Subtle blueberry and raisin notes with a gentle gathering bitterness.

24 Kicking Donkey **4.2%** A best bitter made using UK Pioneer, Cascade and Jester along with local malts and yeast. (gf) (v)

25 Sussex Pale 4.2% A modern pale, loaded with English Cascade and Ernest for an aromatic finish. (gf) (v)

Long Man

25 Best Bitter 4% Perfectly balanced with a bittersweet malty taste, fragrant hops and a long deep finish.

W Rising Giant 4.8% Amber-coloured ale with a citrus fruit aroma and robust bitterness.

23 Session IPA 3.8% A combination of Idaho 7, Ekuanot, Azacca and El Dorado hops give a tropical fruit hit, balanced with resinous pine notes.

29 Dandy 5% A very fruity, hazy pale ale, with Simcoe, Mosaic and Idaho 7 hops liberally used throughout. (v)

Skipper 4.5% Transatlantic pale with a UK/US hop mashup of Centennial and Jester. Smooth with a little twang of spice. (v)

Rother Valley

3 Level Best 4%

This classic beer is a ripe harvest golden colour, brewed with Phoenix hops, leaving a slightly citrus aftertaste.

32 Valley Bitter 3.8% British-hopped traditional bitter.

33 Equinox 4% []

Citrus fruits lead the way with this mild and hazy, generously hopped pale ale.

Hoat Time Are The Red Arrows On? 4.6%

A classic red ale, with a spicy, sticky finish.

35 Session Pale 3.7% □

Light, crisp, peachy and as smooth as anything. A reimagined recipe, with their signature hop choice.

33 Spring Golden 4.5% Floral and moreish, with a blossoming

honey-like sweetness, balanced with earthy malt.

Refreshing and smooth, with notes of caramel and biscuit, and a lovely grassy, herbal freshness. (v)

Vibrant grapefruit and delicate lemon flavours with a refreshing finish.

This brew delivers a subtle sweetness and a hint of earthy undertones, creating a smooth and balanced flavour profile.

48 Pint 3.9% 🛛

This dry session bitter has a light malt base carrying a wonderful display of New Zealand hops, notes of citrus and grapefruit.

🕙 Green Devil 6% 🛛

This contemporary IPA explodes with hop-harvest aromas, packing in big tropical and citrus hop flavours before a crisp, refreshing finish.

A juicy, bright, dry pale. Hopped extensively with Centennial, Citra and Mosaic hops at flame out and dry hop. (v)

60 Day Trippin'6% □

Brewed with Three Legs Brewery, this IPA is packed full of sunshine courtesy of Citra, Galaxy and Simcoe. (v)

6) Frutti Tutu 6% Passion fruit, mango and strawberries balance out this pavlova pastry sour, brewed in the ABYSS. (v)

62 Gonzo 4.6% 🛛

Combined floral, herbal and spice aromas with a subtle bitterness that leaves you wanting more. (gf) (v)

63 Mosaic 4% 0

 \bar{G} luten-free pale ale with bold floral and tropical fruit flavours and aromas. (gf) (v)

Beak (S)

64 Déšť 5% 🛛

Unfiltered, naturally carbonated lager, which is crisp, clean and fizzing with classic noble hop character. (v)

65 Hum 4.8% 🛛

Brewed with Idaho 7, Motueka and Cashmere hops and an experimental yeast strain, for voluptuous body and ripe tropical fruit flavours. (v)

66 Parade 6% 0

This IPA is brimming with fruit bubble gum flavours of mango, orange peel, pineapple and ripe flat peaches. (v)

Braybrooke

67 Keller Lager 4.8%

Unfiltered and unpasteurised lager which keeps all the best flavour while delivering ultimate refreshment. (v)

Brew York

68 Cherry Kola 4.5% 🛛

A tangy sour base is backed up with sweet cherry to maintain some of the juiciness and distinct fizz of this classic sweet. May contain nuts. (v)

Burning Sky (S)

69 NZ Pils 4.6% 0

Fermented cold and lagered for a crisp, dry finish with aromas of cut grass and citrus fruits. (v)

Quench 4.4% 🛛

Sumptuous malts and easy-going bitterness allow white grape, gooseberry and passion fruit flavours of the Nelson Sauvin and Riwaka hop. (v)

V Saison Houblon 5.2%

Crisp drinking, modern Saison loaded with beautiful noble hops for enlightened refreshment and maximum quaffability. (v)

Burnt Mill

2 Beyond the Firs 4.8%

Dry-hopped with Citra, Centennial, Idaho 7 and Simcoe for bright tangerine and grapefruit aromas with a subtle piney bitterness. (gf) (v)

Cloudwater

73 Fresh 0.5% 🛛

Alcohol-free beer. Designed to match the hop impact and body of Cloudwater's alcoholic New England IPAs. (v)

Proper DIPA NZ Edition 8% 🛛

This DIPÅ excels in both body and hop intensity, characterised by NZ hop aromas of white grape, all culminating in a dank finish. (v)

7 Dreams of You 8% **D**

A vibrant DIPA offering a fusion of tropical fruitiness and distinctive Southern Hemisphere aromatics. (v)

GlassHouse

76 Painting Silhouettes 5.5%

Smooth and creamy body from a stout brewed with Peruvian Fairtrade cacao nibs and finest quality vanilla. (v)

Kernel

Dry Stout 4.5%

Boasts a delicious complexity with a blend of roasty notes and hop forward flavours. (v)

78 Table Beer 3% []

For a beer with such a modest ABV, it's packed full of flavour and refreshing hoppy bitterness. (v)

Laine (S)

1 New Wave 6%

A clean, crisp IPA, fermented with lager yeast and packed full of citrusy hops. Expect moderate bitterness and a refreshing hoppy punch. (v)

Lost and Grounded

80 Keller Pils 4.8% 🛛

Pilsner malt from Germany combined with three traditional hop varieties for a clean, hoppy and bitter lager. (v)

Pastore

8 Rio de Pastore 4%

A tropical soda inspired sour made with mangoes, guavas, passion fruit, apricots and oranges. (v)

Route 21 (S)

62 Solero 4.5% American wheat beer loaded with lots of mango and orange, combine for a fruity and juicy beer. (v)

³³ Stroll 5.3% □ Juicy and hazy, with tropical and citrus notes from a double dry hop. (v)

Sureshot

e Propane & Propane Accessories 6.5% □

Explosive flavour IPA double dry-hopped for dank tropical and citrus fumes. (v)

Tartarus

85 Krampus 14.2% 🛛

Indulgent porter, brewed with lactose, cherries, almonds and oranges, and spiced with nutmeg, cloves, cinnamon and ginger. Contains lactose and nuts.

Three Legs (S)

86 Citra and Strata NEPA 5.2% 🛛

Soft and easy New England inspired pale with all the aroma and flavour, minus the high bitterness and ABV. (v)

87 Red Flag 3.5% □

A pale ale infused with English hops. Brewed with the Hastings Project – all profits going to Clean Water Action. (v)

88 Casual Pale 4.5%

Cascade and Mosaic hops bring light pine, citrus and floral notes to this seriously thirst-quenching, gluten-free pale. (gf) (v)

89 Strawberry Sundae 5% 🛛

Sweet and juicy Scottish strawberries pair perfectly with a sour base beer to create something smooth and full-bodied. Contains lactose.
