**Oatmeal Stout** 4.5%  
 Smooth, dark stout with a chocolate sweetness.  
**Pale Ale - Centennial** 4.5%  
 Full flavoured, balanced and sessionable pale ale.

**Adur Chilingers Gold** Local  
 3.7%  
 Light golden chilli ale with a taste of root ginger.  
**Robbie's Red** 5.2%  
 Complex flavours including smoky orange peel.

**Arundel Castle** Local  
 3.8%  
 Balance of malt, fruit and hops with a dry finish.  
**Sussex IPA** 4.5%  
 Fruity hoppy bitter with a sweet finish.

**Arran Guid Ale** National  
 3.8%  
 Balance of malt and fruit with a dry hoppy finish.

**Battle Brewery Conquest** Local  
 4.1%  
 Well-balanced beer with a pleasant finish.  
**One Hop Wonder** 4.0%  
 Understated floral aroma with a hint of lime.

**Bays Topsail** National  
 4.0%  
 Subtle sweetness throughout.

**Bedlam Benchmark** Local  
 4.0%  
 Sweet fruity notes with rich character.  
**Phoenix** 3.9%  
 Bold US hops give its characteristic dry finish.

**Black Hole Milky Way** National  
 6.0%  
 Notes of honey and banana.

**Cheddar Ales Totty Pot** National  
 4.5%  
 Hints of roasted coffee and a creamy malt.

**Cellar Head Red Rye IPA** Local  
 4.5%  
 Rich caramel and chewy toffee notes.  
**Session Pale Ale** 4.2%  
 Gooseberries and grapes with honied sweetness.

**Derwent Mutineers** National  
 4.1%  
 Golden, amber bitter with hints of caramel.

**Empire Moonrakers Mild** National  
 3.8%  
 A chocolatey, malt dark mild.

**Engineer Irish Red Ale** Local  
 5.0%  
 Sweetness balanced with a roasted dry finish.  
**May Mild** 5.8%  
 Subtle hops with lingering malt finish.

**Filo Gold** Local  
 4.8%  
 Golden bitter with refreshing hints of Elderflower.  
**Churches** 4.2%  
 Pale, refreshing ale with long spicy flavours.

**Firebrick Toon Broon** National  
 4.6%  
 Deep amber beer, malty sweetness and liquorice.

**Franklins Lawless** Local  
 3.8%  
 Juicy and fruity session New England pale.  
**What Mama Don't Know** 4.1%  
 Oatmeal pale full of big hitting tropical flavours.

 Floor-malted Maris Otter barley.

**Greyhound Amber Eyes** Local  
 4.2%  
 Light biscuit malt flavours and a bitter finish.  
**B-46** 4.6%  
 Blackberry which leaves a hoppy aftertaste.

 Everyday, easy drinking ale.

**Harveys IPA** Local  
 3.5%  
 Delicate, grassy & earthy hop aroma, bitter and balanced malt flavours.  
**Knots of May** 3.0%  
 Refreshing beer with a light nutty flavour and delicate green herbaceous notes.

 Blonde ale boasting light floral and herbal notes.  
**Keepers Gold** 4.4%  
 Aroma of grapefruit, citrus and spice.

**Itchen Valley Watercress Best** National  
 4.2%  
 Light hoppiness with a slightly peppery finish.

**Joules Pure Blonde** National  
 4.1%  
 Golden ale with bold citrus character.

**Kelburn Pivo Estivo** National  
 3.9%  
 A pale dry, citrus, hoppy session ale.

**Little Valley Dark Vale** National  
 4.5%  
 Rich & roasted vanilla porter.

**Loud Shirt Ecstasy Stout** Local  
 6.6%  
 Full-bodied stout with combinations of flavoursome dark malts.  
**Flowerpower Blonde** 5.1%  
 Combination of elderflower and subtle hops.

**Pictish Alchemist** National  
 4.3%  
 Crisp malt flavours and a robust hoppy finish.

**Riverside Tubbers' Tipple** Local  
 5.6%  
 Spicy characteristic with just a hint of honey.

**Rother Valley Copper Ale** Local  
 4.1%  
 Lovely balance of chocolate malt and WGV hops.  
**Well Sprung** 4.3%  
 Well rounded, well hopped, well made!

**Skye Gold** National  
 4.3%  
 Creamy head and just the right amount of bitterness.

**Three Legs English IPA** Local  
 5.0%  
 Caramel and orange-like maltiness.  
**Oatmeal Stout** 5.0%  
 Full bodied stout with flavours of coffee and liquorice.

**Top Out Smoked Porter** National  
 5.9%  
 Notes from both German smoked beech wood and Scottish peat.

**Vale Brill Gold** National  
 3.5%  
 Fruity, citrus hop aromas and soft bitterness.

**Weltons Old Cockey** Local  
 4.3%  
 Golden beer with a flavour like a good Chablis.  
**Red Rose Mild** 4.9%  
 Red berry flavours, with a lasting finish.

**Windswept APA** National  
 5.0%  
 Smooth malts and a tangy grapefruit finish.

**Worsthorne Red Man** National  
 4.2%  
 A light bitter, with distinct grapefruit aftertaste.

**Gwatkins Malvern Hill (Sweet)** 7.0%  
 Freshly pressed pears on the nose, incredibly juicy.  
**Hecks Red Pear (Med)** 6.0%  
 Made from the Blakeney Red pear variety.  
**Nempnett Piglets Choice (Med)** 6.5%  
 A medium dry, single variety, oak matured cider.

**Oakwood Organic (Dry)** 6.0%  
 Beautifully dry with lots of fruit and great tannins.  
**Pine Trees Farm Pear O'Dudda's (Med)** 5.5%  
 From culinary and dessert pears.

## Let the fun be-Gin!

Try Sussex Blue Gin from local distillery Harley House. This magical gin is inspired by the Adonis Blue butterfly which can be found flying high throughout the county of Sussex. For a modern take on a classic London Dry Gin, try the Generation 11 Sussex Dry from Generation Distillers.

Or why not sample Whitley Neill's Rhubarb & Ginger. The essence of rhubarb adds a tart crisp edge to a smooth English gin base, whilst the ginger extract warms the palate for a full-bodied finish.

## Cocktail Heaven

**Malibu Sunset**  
 A sweet blend of coconut rum, pineapple and grenadine, served with a cherry garnish – punchy and irresistible!

**Aperol Spritz**  
 Classic Italian cocktail of Aperol, Prosecco and soda.

**Woo Woo**  
 Archers peach schnapps topped with vodka and cranberry juice, served on ice, deliciously fruity.
