Destination Devonshire Quarter Eastbourne

The new Welcome Building on the site of the demolished Congress Suite, conveniently positioned between the Congress Theatre and Winter Garden, is now complete and operational. This innovative design links all levels of the new facilities to the established spaces. Two large exhibition halls on semi-basement level replace the demolished Devonshire Park Halls footprint (located the farthest side of the Winter Garden to provide extended Tennis Court provision). A sweeping plaza draws visitors to the conference reception and box office areas behind which lies a café overlooking the famous Tennis Grounds, plus two additional seminar/hospitality spaces and balconies on the top floor.

Renovation is also complete to the Grade II* listed **Congress Theatre**. This extensive upgrade benefits complete replacement of its 1655 seated auditorium, refurbishment of dressing rooms, new ventilation and heating, improved technical and acoustic provisions as well as restoring original internal features to foyers and bars. The accessibility across all levels is vastly improved thanks to its **connectivity to the Welcome Building**.

Supporting this operational offer are the renovated facilities within the **Devonshire Park Theatre**, **International Lawn Tennis Centre** and

newly built Locker Room Venue. Each provide a mix of unique, multi-use spaces supported by AV and on-site catering.

How to

By Road

Main approach is from the M25 via the M23/A23 leading to the A27. An alternative route from London is on the A22 and from the channel ports the A259. The M25 skirts the capital linking Eastbourne to Britain's motorway network at Godstone via the A22.

by RailSouthern Railway operates direct train services every 30 minutes during the day with a journey time of just 90 minutes from London Victoria. www.southernrailway.com

Regular services link Eastbourne with Ashford International and Eurostar services to Paris, Lille and Brussels. South Coast trains from Scotland. the North West, the Midlands and the East which by-pass London, link conveniently with Eastbourne services at either Gatwick Airport or Hayward's Heath.

By Air

London Gatwick Airport is an hour away by rail or car and Heathrow and Stansted Airports are about two hours drive via the M25.

By Sea

The nearest ferry service operates just 20 minutes away, from Newhaven to Dieppe. The Channel Tunnel, Folkestone and Dover are about 11/2 hours drive away (east) and Portsmouth is about 1% hours drive (west). Eastbourne's Sovereign Harbour Marina offers berthing 24 hours a day to accommodate visiting yachts and cruises. www.sovereignharbour.co.uk
