Out & About



Walkies!

Eastbourne is a fabulous place for dog walking. Nestled between the sea and the downs there are so many options. This includes the longer South Downs Way, the 1066 Country Walk and Cuckoo Trail which walkers can choose to walk shorter linear sections of. These give brilliant opportunities for dogs to have a great off lead run.

Here are just a few recommendations of shorter options:

Abbotts Wood: Arlington Polegate, BN26 6SL for car park. There are signposted walking trails, a medieval lake, play area, barbecues for hire, picnic tables and toilets. Amazing arrays of bluebells in Spring and a gorgeous display of autumnal colours later in the year. After a stroll around the woods why not treat yourself to a delicious snack at the nearby dog friendly Arlington Tea Rooms? Turn left as you come out of the car park, and it is a short drive down the road on your right.

Butchers Hole: Old Willingdon Road, East Dean, BN20 OAT for car park. Part of Friston Forest. There are signposted trails. Great place for butterfly spotting when you get up the hill and onto the open grassland, so a lovely, varied terrain for the woofs.

Friston Forest: Littlington Road, BN25 4AJ. An expansive beech woodland with numerous trails and paths and plenty of great sniffs thanks to the local wildlife. There is a signposted loop walk with views of the White Horse carved into the hills. Barbecue Hire is available and there is a toilet block.

Seven Sisters Country Park: There are two car parks one on the side of the road by the river, the other just immediately after your turn into Littlington

Road. BN25 4AD. There is also a number 12 bus stop. There is a Visitors Centre that provides maps of various trails, a café and toilet block. There is also a refreshments van on the river side of the road. You can choose to either walk into Friston Forest or explore the Seven Sisters Country Park. There is a lovely circular walk if you follow the path from the car park on the river side. Follow the trail to the beach then turn left and walk along the well-worn track on the pebbles until you see a path turning back inland on your right. Follow this and you will rejoin your original path. Magnificent place for bird spotting and glorious sunsets and sun rises. Water-dogs can enjoy a swim or paddle in the waters.

There are parking charges for all the above car parks but if you are a resident or staying in the area for a long period of time it is well worth purchasing a Friston Forest membership from Forestry England.

For just £38 per annum, you get to park for free in Abbotts Wood, Friston Forest, Seven Sisters Country Park and Butchers Hole. www.forestryengland.uk

Arlington Reservoir: BN26 6TF A scenic circular walk around the reservoir. Toilet block and café in the car park.

Eastbourne to East Dean: A gentle linear walk. Park by the YMCA and walk up the hill towards the Eastbourne Downs Golf Club, which is a dog friendly refreshment stop (there is a number 12 bus stop here for those who use public transport.) Whilst near the course, please make sure dogs are kept within sight or on leads. Turn right onto the South Downs Way.

After a few yards there is a made-up road on your left.

Follow this down by the side of the golf course.

The road ends by a local farm. Keep following the track it becomes down into the Valley where it joins Downs View Lane. Follow the lane to the end and turn right following the pavement along the busy A259 East Dean Road. Take the turning on the left towards the Village Hall which is the site of a bustling market and craft fair every Wednesday. Follow the path up by the side of the Village Hall and treat yourself to refreshments at the dog friendly Hikers Rest or Tiger Inn. Look out for the blue plaque on Sherlock Holmes retirement cottage! To get back to Eastbourne either retrace your steps or board the number 12 bus from the A259.

Shinewater Park: BN23 8EJ. Parking in nearby roads or use buses that stop in Larkspur Drive. A lovely circular route taking in lakes much of it hard surfaced although a few short stretches can get muddy. There are no toilets on site.

Dogs On The Beach

Holywell to the Harbour: Eastbourne has 4.1 miles of glorious promenade, dotted with dog friendly places to stop off for a cup of tea or coffee. Start at one end and admire the fantastic views and changing scenery as you progress along the way. From the almost Mediterranean feel of Holywell and the Italian Gardens via the Bandstand and Sovereign Park to the modern harbour. See if you can get a glimpse of the seals there. From April to September you can ride back to your original point on the dog friendly Dotto!

Please be aware that from 1st May to 30th September dogs must be kept on a lead on the lower prom from the Wish Tower and then all the way, as you head east, to the harbour.

Dogs are not allowed on the beaches between the Wish Tower and the Pier during the same period.

Public Parks & Gardens

Eastbourne has a host of great parks and gardens where dogs are welcome. Parks are not secure so take care if your dog is off lead. Some require dogs to be on leads. Please follow the guidelines.

All Saints Park: BN20 7GD. A small, picturesque park in the Meads area. Five Acre Field BN22 7SG. A good open space for games and exercise.

Gildredge Park and Manor Gardens: BN20 8BB. Large open spaces plus a wooded area with lots of squirrels! Amenities include 2 dog friendly cafes and a toilet block. Dogs to be kept on a lead in Manor Gardens which are locked each night. Check the gates for closing times.

Hampden Park: BN22 9QR. A huge expanse with wooded areas, open spaces, and a lake. There is a café (dogs only allowed on the terrace) and a toilet block.

Helen Garden: BN20 7XL. A small park with spectacular sea views. There is a kiosk and toilet block.

Italian Gardens: BN20 7XL. Another small park but usually very quiet so a good place to do some dog training.

MacMillan Drive Dog Park: BN21 1SX. Unfortunately the fence here is very low so not totally dog proof. However, it is a good spot to meet up and socialise. for doas and humans!

Motcombe Gardens: BN21 1QF. A small ornate gardens with pond. Dogs should be kept on a lead here.

Old Town Recreation Ground: BN20 8JJ. A wide-open area to give the dog a good run. Toilet facilities available. Cafe coming soon.

Princes Park: BN22 7LL. Large park on the seafront with boating lake, toilet block and a dog friendly cafe.

Seaside Rec: BN22 8JU. A green space amongst housing and shops. There's an all-weather path used by dog walkers.

Shinewater Park: BN23 8DA. A great circular walk, currently no amenities.



Days Out With Dogs

Looking for a day out with the woof? Here are a few ideas:

Birling Gap: East Dean BN20 OAB. Walk up the cliffs to the Belle Tout Lighthouse. The café and shop are both dog friendly. For safety reasons please keep you and your woof at a safe distance from the cliff edge. For further information visit www.nationaltrust.org.uk

Bodiam Castle: Robertsbridge, TN32 5UA. Dogs are welcome in the grounds and the castle view café but not in the castle. For further information visit www.nationaltrust.org.uk

Hellingly Dog Park: Hellingly BN27 4EP. A fun dog agility course that is free to use. Set in the lovely Hellingly Country Park Hellingly Dog Park

Herstmonceaux Castle: Hailsham BN27 1RN. Dogs are welcome in the grounds and gardens. www.herstmonceux-castle.com

Kent and East Sussex Railway: Bodiam Station TN32 5RA. Take your woof for a trip on a steam train. For timetable www.kesr.org.uk.

Leonardslee Gardens: Brighton Road, RH13 6PP. The gardens, grounds, courtyard café and dolls house are all dog friendly. Take your woof to visit the wallabies! www.leonardsleegardens.co.uk

Nymans: Handcross, RH17 6EB. Dogs are permitted in the gardens during the winter months only - but in the woodland all year round. For further information visit www.nationaltrust.org.uk

Pevensey Castle: Castle Road, BN24 5LE. Dogs on leads are welcome throughout the site. For further information visit www.english-heritage.org.uk

Rathfinny Estate: Alfriston, BN26 5TU. Visit a local winery. Dogs are welcome on the self-guided walking trail and at the cellar door shop www. rathfinnyestate.com

Raystede Centre for Animal Welfare: The Broyle, BN8 5AJ. You need to book free tickets before you go at www.raystede.org as numbers are

restricted for animal welfare reasons. Visit a range of animals in care at the centre or looking for homes. Support their work by visiting the dog friendly shop or cafe on site.

Seven Sisters Country Park: Seaford BN25 4AD. See the suggestions on the walkies page for details. www.sevensisters.org.uk

Sheffield Park: Uckfield, TN22 3QX. Dogs are welcome in the garden (except Saturday mornings before 1 pm), on the parkland, in Walk Wood, in the shop and the Garden Room at the Coach House Café. For further information visit www.nationaltrust.org.uk

The Long Man of Wilmington: Wilmington, BN26 5SW. This is a great walk with marvellous views. www.sussexpast.co.uk/attraction/the-long-man-of-wilmington

Michelam Priory: Upper Dicker, Hailsham, BN27 3QS. Dogs are welcome to walk all around the 7 acres of grounds but not allowed in the priory or café. www.sussexpast.co.uk/attraction/michelham-priory

Wakehurst Place: Ardingly, RH17 6TN. Up to 2 dogs per adult are permitted entry. There is a dedicated dog walking route that takes in different sights, sounds, and smells. If your dog needs a run there is an off-lead area by the millennium seed bank. There are plenty of water bowls dotted around plus biodegradable poo bags and bins. The Seeds Café and Stable Pantry are both dog friendly eateries. www.kew.org/wakehurst

Dog Walking Fields

Sometimes a dog needs a larger space than a garden where you are in control of the environment. Maybe to focus on training, your dog is recuperating from an op, your bitch is on heat, space for your dog to have a good run if they have poor recall, or for a reactive woof wary of other dogs that needs an exercise space where they feel safe.

If so, a private hire dog walking field can be a real blessing. A large fenced in space for you to have exclusive access.

Here are a few tried and tested private hire fields in the local area.

Freedom Fields: A choice of two fields, soon to be three. One in Stone Cross (Freedom Bluebells, BN24 5BJ), two in Battle (Freedom Run, TN33 0LS and coming soon Freedom Sniff). 1.5-2 acres with 6 feet fencing, agility equipment, shelter and eco-friendly poo bags supplied. Take your own water. www.freedomfields.org.uk

Heatherdene Hideaway: BN24 5BS. 2-acre field with 6-foot fences and an abundance of trees for sniffs! Take your own water. www.heatherdenehideaway.co.uk

Holmans Dog Walking Fields: TN21 OAX. 3-acre field with 6-foot fencing and for an extra £2 per hour the option of additionally booking the 7-acre field with 4 foot fencing. Our dogs love the huge amount of space - gives them the feel of a real downland walk, www.holmansfields.co.uk

Scrays Dog Field: TN33 ONR. 2-acre field with 5.5-foot fencing. Plenty of shelter around the sides of the field. Off-road parking **1** Scrays Dog Field.

Southdowns Unleashed: The choice of an indoor barn or a 2-acre field with 6 feet fencing. The barn is astro turfed with a small amount of agility equipment, a ball pit and lighting. The field has open spaces and trees and shrubs. www.southdownsunleashed.co.uk

The Big Barn - The Ultimate Dog Walking Field & Facility



The Big Barn must be one of the best dog walking fields and is made up of four different facilities:

- The Big Barn: a huge indoor sand-based arena with agility equipment, room for a good run and an outside woodchipped area.
- The Fun Field: 2 acres of grass enclosed by high fencing, obstacles and shelter.
- The Sand Pit: a high fenced, sand-based area. Plenty of room for a good run plus obstacles, and shelter.
- The Playground: with Splash and Dash water play for dogs.

The facility is open from 6am to 10pm, 7 days a week. The barn and sandpit have coin operated lighting for the darker evenings. There is ample onsite parking available plus fresh water, dog treats, poo bags and poo bins, and for the humans, drinks machines and toilets. Claire, the owner, continually strives to improve and add to the facilities available. Book online but be aware this facility is extremely popular so do book well in advance to avoid disappointment!

Please note there is a two car limit on each facility.

The Beacon - Eastbourne's Dog Friendly Shopping Centre



Eastbourners and visitors are welcome to take their dogs shopping with them in the town centre's premium shopping centre. Previously only guide and assistance dogs were allowed but in 2021 the then director, and dog owner, James Roberts introduced the change. James, whose Beagle, Barkley, often accompanied him to work, said: "I think banning dogs is unnecessary and antiquated. A ban makes the assumption that dog owners do not have control over their pets which is not the case. The majority of owners have well behaved dogs, and it just makes life a lot easier if they can be brought into the centre in line with a number of shops who now welcome dogs."

Most of the shops in the Beacon are now dog friendly - for a full list check out the retail section in this guide. Permitting dogs into shopping centres is unusual and we are so lucky to have a forward-thinking establishment like The Beacon taking the initiative on this. Owners are expected to keep their pets on a lead.

Dog Trainers and Behaviourists

A dog trainer understands how dogs learn and will help you teach your dog new skills.

A dog behaviourist will be able to help you with any problem behaviour issues such as reactivity or separation anxiety.

They will analyse and diagnose what the problem is and work with you and your dog on ways to improve or eliminate the behaviour.

If a problem behaviour does arise it may be worth seeing your vet first before seeking a behaviourist's help as in some cases, it may be that a medical reason is the root of the problem.

Doggie Dos & Don'ts



Life is much more pleasant for all of us if we act in a considerate manner towards each other, our dogs, other people's dogs and our environment so please:

- DO always pick up after your dog and dispose of waste in an appropriate bin or take it home with you.
- DO NOT take your dogs on the beaches from the Wish Tower to The Pier between 1st May - 30th September.
- DO keep your dogs on a lead when on the beaches East of the Pier, in Manor Gardens and Motcombe Gardens.
- DO NOT take your dogs out in extreme weather no dog ever died from missing a walk!
- DO put your off-lead dog back on the lead if an on-lead dog approaches. Dogs can be on a lead for many reasons such as recovering from an operation, disability, reactivity or in training. The last thing that dog and dog owner need is your off-lead dog rushing up to theirs.
- DO NOT leave your dog in a car in hot weather. If you see a dog left in a hot car dial 999.
- DO be aware of 'yellow' dogs wearing a yellow harness/ lead/coat. These dogs need space for a variety of reasons. So please keep your dog at a distance.
- DO NOT be one of the 'It's OK my dog is friendly' brigade. There are people and dogs that are nervous of dogs. How would you feel about a stranger invading your personal space? Keep your dog under control and do not let it run up to unfamiliar people or dogs.
